

What's DutchTrig?

DutchTrig is a vaccine developed to prevent Dutch Elm Disease. It works much like your annual flu shot. We inject your tree with DutchTrig once a year to decrease its chances of contracting Dutch Elm Disease.

Like other vaccines, DutchTrig increases the likelihood of your elm's survival, but is of course not a guarantee.

DutchTrig is nontoxic and is safe for humans, animals, and the environment.

DutchTrig is our first defence against Dutch Elm Disease.
